

Description of Aegis Soldier Frass™



Fine and homogenous larvae frass that is high in bio-available nitrogen, minerals and nutrients.

Frass is the residue that is left after the larvae have recycled the nutrients. It is a mixture of larvae castings and some undigested cellulose. You can also make a frass tea by soaking the frass overnight in water and then using the water a foliar feed, that has biopesticidal properties.
